**Subject: 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Spartan Classic Golf Tournament**

We would like to take this opportunity to introduce ourselves to you and at the same time tell you about our program's 4th annual golf tournament. Over the past several years both the football and band programs have grown in membership from a group of 40 students to over 200. Each musician and athlete strives for performance excellence on the stage, field and in the classroom. These two programs are the largest on the South High campus. They provide students with a well rounded education by teaching leadership, dedication, courage, commitment, team work and community. Many of the students involved in these programs grow up to become community and business leaders.

This year we invite you to join us for our annual benefit golf tournament held at Los Verdes Country Club. Each year our programs receive very modest funding from the school and this year is no exception. In order to equip the additional enrolled students and continue to strive for excellence our music and football programs must do a substantial amount of fundraising on our own. This year, our major fundraiser will be a golf tournament held at Los Verdes Golf Course in Rancho Palos Verdes. All funds raised will go toward several expenses, including:

- New instruments, costing in the range of \$2,000-\$10,000 apiece.
- New concert performance attire, costing \$7,000.
- New state of the art tackling equipment, costing in range of \$5,000 - \$7,000.
- New home uniforms, costing \$10,000.
- Travel expenses for various competitions, ranging in cost of \$2,000-\$5,000

As you can see this is an enormous undertaking. We have been working hard to build the Spartan band and football programs into highly competitive groups. This past year, our football team finished a third in the Pioneer League and went to the 1<sup>st</sup> round of CIF play-offs. Our Marching band had an outstanding season as well as they captured 1<sup>st</sup> in their final competition of the season.
